The Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) presents its compliments to the IAEA's Member States and has the honour to draw their attention to the **Educational Workshop for Permanent Mission Representatives on the Convention on Nuclear Safety** (hereinafter referred to as "event") to be held at the IAEA's Headquarters in Vienna, Austria, on **8 July 2024**.

The purpose of the event is to provide Permanent Mission representatives with an introduction and overview of the Convention on Nuclear Safety (CNS), its obligations and the peer review process, as well as the adherence process to the CNS.

The detailed programme of the workshop, which will be held in English, will be shared in due course.

Member States are invited to designate one or more participants to represent the Government at this event. Member States are strongly encouraged to identify suitable women participants.

The IAEA is not in a position to bear the travel and other costs of participants in the event.

The IAEA also does not provide health insurance coverage for participants in IAEA events. Arrangements for private insurance coverage on an individual basis should therefore be made. The IAEA will, however, provide insurance coverage for accidents and illnesses that clearly result from any work performed for the IAEA.

Designations should be submitted to the IAEA through the competent national authority (Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Permanent Mission to the IAEA or National Atomic Energy Authority) not later than **6 May 2024** using the attached Participation Form (Form A). The Scientific Secretary of the event will liaise with the participants directly concerning further arrangements, as appropriate, once the official designations have been received.
