The Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) presents its compliments to the IAEA's Member States and has the honour to draw their attention to the **International Ministerial Conference on Nuclear Power** (hereinafter referred to as "event") to be held in Incheon, Republic of Korea, from **27 to 29 October 2026**.

The purpose of the event is to provide a forum for ministers, policymakers, senior officials and experts to engage in high-level dialogue on the role of nuclear energy in meeting clean energy demand, contributing to energy security, energy systems resilience and sustainable development, as well as to discuss and exchange views on the key issues related to the development and deployment of nuclear energy.

The working languages of the conference will be all the official IAEA languages: Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian, and Spanish.

Member States are invited to disseminate the attached Announcement to the target audience for the event and to designate participants using the InTouch+ platform, as indicated in Section E. Member States are strongly encouraged to designate women participants.

The IAEA is generally not in a position to bear the travel and other costs of participants in the event. The IAEA has, however, limited funds at its disposal to help meet the cost of attendance of certain participants.

It should be noted that compensation is not payable by the IAEA for any damage to or loss of personal property. The IAEA also does not provide health insurance coverage for participants in events. Arrangements for private insurance coverage on an individual basis should therefore be made. The IAEA will, however, provide insurance coverage for accidents and illnesses that clearly result from any work performed for the IAEA.

The Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the IAEA's Member States the assurances of its highest consideration.
